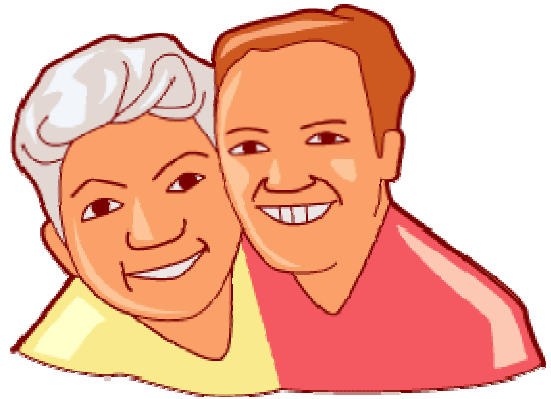




## Day Trips



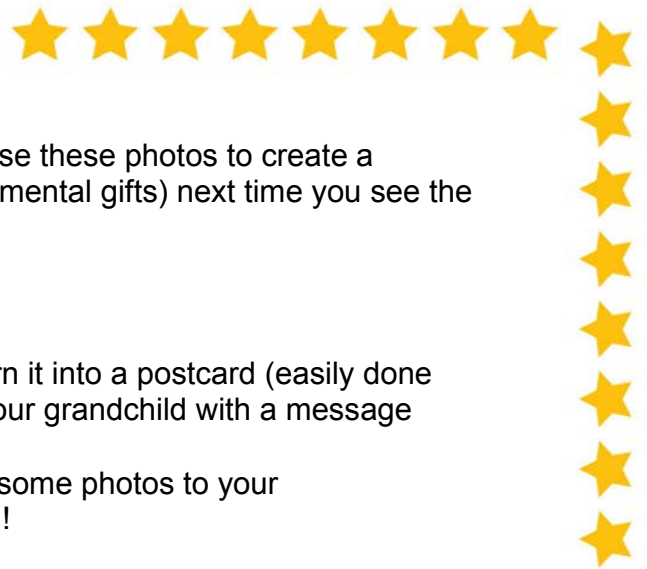
**A day out with the Grandchildren doesn't have to be expensive. Try one of the activities below!**

- Visit the museum

- Go to an exhibition - you will find a free listing in most local papers
- Take a trip on public transport - young children love going on buses, trains and ferries... the trip is more exciting than the destination



### Extra Tips

- You can plan your trip together. Have the Grandchildren help look up transport options, plan the menu and help make/bake it and then get them to pack their bag for the day. Planning your day trip together gives you all something to look forward to the next time you see each other
