



Ideas for Show and Tell



If you dread the note that comes home announcing 'Show and Tell', here are some ideas to help you and your child prepare and enjoy this popular activity.

What's in the Bag?

- Place an object in a closed bag.
- Ask your child to prepare 3 clues to assist their class in guessing "what is in the bag?" Record these on a piece of paper if necessary.
- Practise with your child at home.

'My Favourites' - Collage

- Find and cut out/draw and cut out pictures of favourite things, paste them onto a piece of card and present in a colourful and eye-catching way.
- Practise sharing what these things are with your child. Also discuss saying why they were chosen as favourites.

Let's Play

- Teach your child a new outdoor game.
- Have them practise explaining the rules.
- They can teach the class the game and then perhaps play it at lunchtime.
